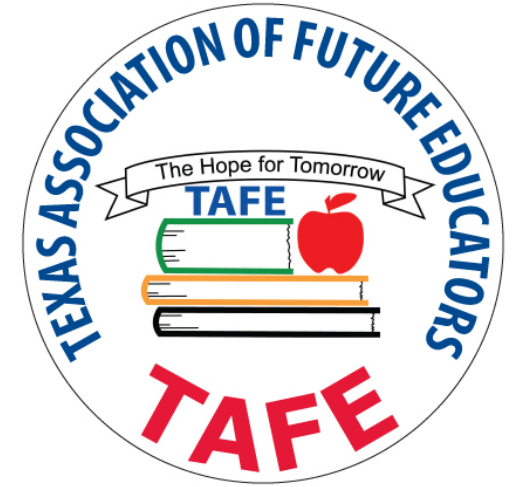

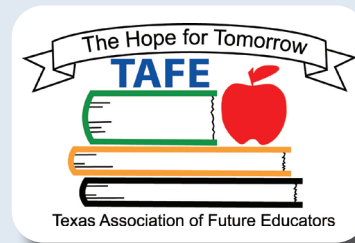

Appreciation: Join in teacher appreciation activities to make a difference.

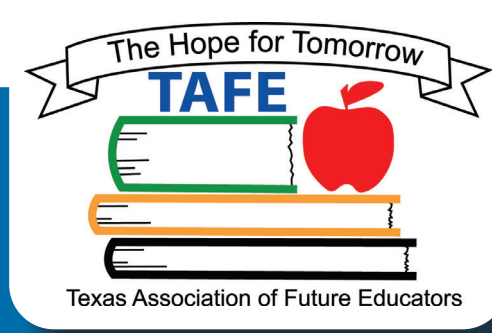
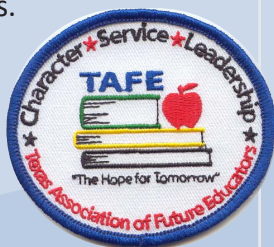
Fundraising: Work together with your peers to raise funds to support the projects in which the local organization participates.
