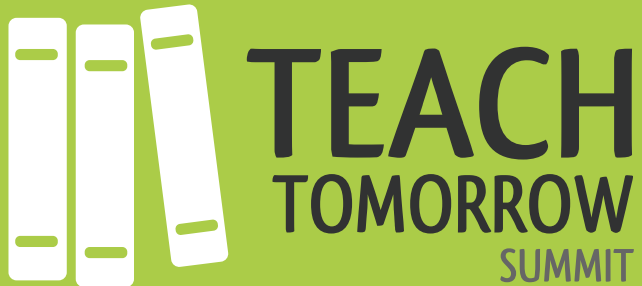

Stacey Bess

Stacey Bess's first teaching assignment, the only job she could find, at The School with No Name. In a small shed behind a community homeless shelter Stacey Bess taught Kindergarten through sixth grade to children with no homes and little hope, an experience that effected a profound change in the teacher as well as her students. Stacey discovered that by teaching and modeling love, self-worth, personal power, and courage she could reach children who had previously been labeled unteachable. These children have grown into living proof that Stacey's methods work. Her memoir *Nobody don't love Nobody* inspired the Hallmark Hall of Fame Movie "Beyond the Blackboard."

Stacey has a bachelor's degree in elementary education from the University of Utah. Her outstanding service has been recognized with a number of awards on the local, state, and national levels, including the National Jefferson Award for Greatest Public Service.



Dr. John M. Folks

Dr. John M. Folks, Superintendent of Northside ISD, heads one of the largest and fastest-growing school districts in Texas. Folks has been an educator for 41 years and this year was named the 2011 Texas Superintendent of the Year by the Texas Association of School Boards. Dr. Folks has served as Superintendent of Northside since July 2002 and is the former top education leader for the state of Oklahoma and the former Superintendent of Spring ISD in Houston.

Dr. Folks also has served as Superintendent of the Midwest City-Del City Public Schools in suburban Oklahoma City and as Dean of the School of Education at Southwestern Oklahoma State University. A native of Oklahoma who earned his bachelor's, master's, and doctorate degrees from the University of Oklahoma, Dr. Folks began his teaching career in Port Arthur, Texas.

A vocal advocate for public education, Dr. Folks is Past President of the Texas Association of School Administrators and serves on the Executive and Legislative committees. He currently serves on the Steering Committee of the Fast Growth School Coalition, on the Board of Directors of the Texas Academic Decathlon, and the Texas Education Reform Foundation/Texas Education Reform Caucus. Dr. Folks also is a Past President of the Texas School Alliance and a Past President of the Texas Association of Suburban/Mid-Urban Schools.
