I, the undersigned Participant or Parent or Legal Guardian of Participant, fully understand and agree that participation in the above Activity associated with the Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) and/or the Hyatt Regency Lost Pines Resort and Spa, or other activities, such as riding in an LCRA vehicle, getting in and out of an LCRA vehicle, rafting, kayaking, canoeing, swimming, participating in low and high elements on the challenge course or using LCRA equipment or my own personal equipment, may result in accidental or other physical injury or property damage. I assume all the foregoing risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury or damage. I, for myself, my heirs, legal representatives, and assigns agree to assume the risk of such injury or damage and do hereby RELEASE, ACQUIT, and FOREVER DISCHARGE LCRA and their respective successors, assigns, directors, agents, and employees (collectively referred to herein as "Released Parties"), from any and all manner of causes of action, lawsuits, claims, demands, judgments, and damages of every kind and character, known or unanticipated, including, but not limited to, claims of Released Parties negligence or the condition or use of the property of any of the Released Parties, that I have or could have against the Released Parties or any of them, resulting from or arising out of participation in the Activity. The Released Parties shall not be liable or responsible for, and shall be saved and held harmless by me from and against any and all claims and damages of every kind, including reasonable and necessary costs and attorneys' fees, for injury to or death of any person and for damage to or loss of property, which I, or my heirs or assigns, have or may have arising out of or associated with, directly or indirectly, the Activity or the condition of property owned or controlled by the Released Parties. LCRA shall not be responsible for any lost or stolen items of personal property.

To the extent that LCRA sponsored activities occur on property owned by Marjorie A Leach or by Charles E Rabensburg, this release shall also apply to all accidental or physical injury or property damage occurring on the Leach Property and shall, in addition, release Marjorie A Leach, Charles E Rabensburg, and their respective heirs, executors and assigns on the same terms and to the same extent as the release in favor of LCRA in the paragraph above.

First aid will be available and medical and/or hospital care will be provided in case of serious illness or injury. I understand that if serious illness or injury occurs to my child, I (the undersigned legal parent or guardian) will be notified. I give permission for the participant to receive emergency treatment or surgery as recommended by the attending physician.

By signing this release, I state and declare that I have read it carefully, that I understand all of its terms, and that I voluntarily execute it with full knowledge of its legal consequences.

What to Bring Checklist

To make your stay at McKinney Roughs enjoyable and safe, please bring personal items and clothing that are appropriate for outdoor activities and the Texas climate. When packing, visitors should keep in mind that they may not be able to check into their dormitory immediately upon arrival, depending on departure time for other groups. Any items they might need upon arrival should be easily accessible. **If your group is not participating in outdoor programs, some of the items listed may be optional**

Each group receives one key per dormitory floor so the dorms may be locked while groups participate in activities. However, the storage bins in the dormitories are open cubes that cannot be locked, so we recommend that valuables be left at home and luggage and personal items be labeled with the name of the owner and organization. Remember to check the dormitories prior to departure for personal items. We are not responsible for personal property lost, stolen, or damaged during your visit.

Reminders

- Only bottled water is allowed in the dormitories.
- Snacks and beverages may be stored in the group's meeting room or in the dining hall. Please remember that these items will attract critters and must be kept out of the dormitories!
- There are vending machines with cold beverages and snacks for sale.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.
- At approximately 10 p.m., the dining hall is locked for the evening unless prior arrangements are made with staff.
- Visitors may smoke in designated areas only. Any groups who smoke in the dorms will bear the cost to remove all smoke damage, including but not limited to the cost to replace all bedding in both floors of the dormitory in which that group resided.
- Any groups wishing to serve alcohol must request permission to do so in writing at least 30 days prior to their visit. Alcohol cannot be served if there are residential youth groups present nor can it be served until after the park closes to the public at 5 p.m.
- Entrance gates are locked at approximately 5 p.m. Prior to the group's arrival and again at check-in, the group contact will receive the gate code and list of after-hours emergency contact numbers.
- Key return – please remember to return the dormitory keys to the Visitors Center front desk or your on-site staff contact prior to departure.
