Recently, legislators introduced House Bill 8, a proposal to replace the current end-of-year STAAR test with three shorter tests spread throughout the school year. Under this bill, the TEA would be required to provide immediate data to teachers and parents, giving them time to respond and support student learning.

When examining a topic like standardized testing, it's important to consider all perspectives—the data these tests provide, how they affect teachers and students, and how we use that information to help every learner grow. Texas has relied on STAAR for years, but by the time many of us are in the classroom, the system may look very different—reminding us that education, like a garden, is always changing and evolving.

Over the next few weeks, as you balance midterms, extracurriculars, and academics, it's easy to feel overwhelmed. But remember—growth doesn't happen all at once. Just like a seed takes time, care, and sunlight blooms, your journey as a future educator will take patience and persistence. Believe in yourself, stay focused, and finish the semester strong.

Keep pushing forward, stay positive, and let's finish the year strong!!




