


TEXAS SHINES AT EDUCATORS RISING NATIONAL CONFERENCE

We're thrilled to share that Texas had the largest delegation at the Educators Rising National Conference—representing one-third of all attendees, with an incredible 1,123 participants! Our state received well-deserved national recognition thanks to the outstanding performance of our competitors. A special shoutout to Journey Harris, who led an inspiring and impactful conference for future educators across the country. We couldn't be prouder!

Overall Texas won big with:

- Blue Ribbons 23
- Top 3 89
- Red Ribbons 49

- White Ribbons 38

Summer flew by! It's hard to believe, but area conferences are just around the corner. We're gearing up for another exciting season



- Recognize a student of the month who shows leadership or growth at your chapter meetings.
- Spotlight a teacher of the month with a note, treat, or small gift to show appreciation.
- Create a "Bloom Board" to highlight honorees or spread kindness with flowerthemed notes.
- Do what fits your members best and let your garden grow!



- New Rubrics & prompts will be released at the end of August.
- 2 New Competitions:
 - o Lesson Planning and Delivery-Professional Development this event will be our State version of the event. It has yet to be decided if it will be an individual or team event.
 - o *A Child Development Associate* competition that allows the competitor to work on their credentials while competing.
- Adding the following language to rubrics:
 - o Registering in the wrong division will result in disqualification
 - o Changes to competitors must be made 7 days prior to conference
 - o Spanish competitions must be entirely in Spanish, including Q&A; No English is spoken
- Removing the following language from rubrics:
 - o About recordings
 - o References to district in collegiate competitions
 - About a Bulletin Board in Teacher Created materials (changed to Table display)
- All rubrics are being overhauled and reviewed during the 2025-2026 school year. When the new rubrics are released in the fall of 2026, rubrics will be differentiated for divisions.

TAFE Updates:

- 2025-2026 membership renewal is now open! Your state and national affiliation must happen BEFORE your students are allowed to compete at Area Conferences in the Fall. This is not optional. Educators Rising dues need to be paid by December 1st. As a reminder all dues for Educators Rising students will be invoiced by our office to teacher leaders. Please review the EdRising Membership Info page for more details.
- Beginning in September teacher leader resources and board meeting minutes will only be viewable by logging into the website. We are also launching a new TAFE store order form in September. Be on the lookout for it!
- Teach Tomorrow Summit Registration cost Increase:
 - Early Bird \$98 per attendee
 - 0 Late Registration \$120 per attendee
 - Reminder: No unpaid attendees can attend any portion of the conference. This includes parents, judges and spectators.



Judges Fee Increase:

- 1-4 competitors, one judge or \$200
- 5-14 competitors, two judges or \$400 0
- 15+ competitors, three judges or \$600
- Credit of \$50 for each additional judge brought to conference for up to a \$200 credit.

TAFE Housing Policy:

- Approved by the board of directors in our June Board meeting there is a NEW housing policy.
- "To ensure the safety, well-being, and effective management of participants during Texas Association of Future Educators (TAFE) events, we are implementing a policy that requires all attendees to stay at the officially designated conference hotel(s). This means all registered attendees of the Teach Tomorrow Summit, must be a registered quest at one of the conference hotels listed on the website."
 - Exceptions will be granted only for documented medical or accessibility-related needs and must be submitted in writing 30 days to TAFE State director prior to the Teach Tomorrow Summit.
 - Compliance will be verified at check-in, and noncompliance may result in disqualification or removal from event participation.
- Area conference registration is coming October 1st October 15th, with Area Conferences following soon after in November and December. Area conference dates and locations have been posted under each area tab on the www.tafeonline.org website.
