COMPETITION GUIDELINES:

- A. General Competitive Events Guidelines must be followed.
- B. All complete applications received will be scored by a selection committee.
- C. Chapters must attend one of the following: Summer Workshop, Teach Tomorrow Summit or Region Conference.
- D. All schools that achieve at least 500 points will be recognized as Outstanding TAFE Chapters. Schools receiving 400 - 499 points will be recognized with an Honorable Mention certificate.
- E. The chapter with the highest number of points will be recognized as the Outstanding TAFE Chapter and will receive special recognition on stage at the Annual Teach Tomorrow Summit.

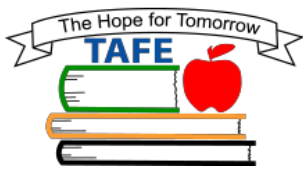
