APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications should be completed in full and returned with the required documentation. The scholarship committee will evaluate all applications and determine the scholarship winner.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

- Be a resident of the state of Texas
- Be a 2024 graduate of a Texas high school
- Have a grade average of 85 or above in all course work
- Have been an active member of Texas Association of Future Educators
- Meet entrance requirements of Texas college or university which offers a degree in education
- Enroll in an accredited university or college in the Fall of 2024
- MAJOR IN ANY AREA OF EDUCATION
- Submit one completed application, one transcript and two letters of recommendation.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- All applications must be typed in 12 pt. font.
- High school and/or college transcript with class ranking must be provided
- A copy of SAT and/or ACT test scores must be provided
- Two letters of recommendation are required
- Each scholarship has an essay component and must be included.
- Application form and all supporting documents identified on the application submitted online by January 26 at 5:00 p.m. CST.
- Recipient will be required to attend the TAFE Teach Tomorrow Summit and be present at the Opening General Session on Wednesday, February 28, 2024 to accept the scholarship. In the event, the winner does not attend the conference; the scholarship committee will determine an alternate who will be awarded the said scholarship.
